
The Good Exchange platform brings together a funder and relevant charitable projects through an automated matching system via a simple, single on-line application form.

#### One funding process-tailored exactly to your needs

Charitable trusts and corporate funders can use The Good Exchange to set up, publish and manage funding schemes and grant rounds based on precise funding criteria (project size or type, organisational income, type of organisation, charitable category and location for example). Every registered funder sees every application that meets their funding criteria, helping to ensure that funding goes to the best and most closely-suited requests and areas of greatest need.

- Charities only need to complete a single on-line application for their project which is then automatically matched with multiple funders, making it easy to for each party to find out what support is available for their project(s) both locally and nationally.
- The ability for funders to offer their grants as match funding significantly increases the number of donors and fundraisers supporting charitable projects.
- Applicants can also add fundraising events and ask for donations in one place to accelerate reaching funding targets.

Extract data about all shortlisted and matched charitable projects directly from The Good Exchange platform into Funders' CRM solutions to increase the efficiency of grant administration processes and decision-making and facilitate greater engagement with supported causes.

Projects that do not meet the requirements of a specific funders' grant round or funding programme will remain on The Good Exchange platform and can continue to fundraise and gather donations. They also have the opportunity to be matched with suitable funds if and when such monies become available.

Take control of the bigger picture by working strategically and collaboratively with other funding organisations to use place-based funding to address the root causes of major social issues.


#### A Trusted, Charity-Owned, Not-for-Profit Platform

It is also registered with the Financial Conduct Authority under the Payment Services Regulations 2017 (FRN: 797421) for the provision of payment services, complying with regulatory obligations such as the requirement to detect and deter money laundering, protect its clients' data and treat its customers fairly.
