Thanks Misha. So if, say 25% of our work is supporting families in W Berks (with the rest elsewhere), would that preclude us from W Berks-specific match-funding?		You can add one project for the whole of Berks and state the WB percentage in the project details (which will be useful for Greenham Trust). Multiple funders can support one project with grants and/or match funding. If you prefer you could add two projects, one per area, but I would be inclined to go with the first option.
